"贝林时报"于10月10日全文登载了中国大使馆发言人金智健政务参赞的文章。金参赞对"贝林时报"9月24刊登的所谓中国工业"间谍"的文章进行了批驳。全文如下:

A Terrifying Fairy Tale

There came an article in Berlingske Sunday Magazine September 24 with a sensational big-letter topic *Dragon's Spies (Dragens Spioner)*, telling how thousands of Chinese spies are stealing Denmark's high-tech under the cover of students, guest researchers, and businessmen. The article claimed that Denmark was in special threat posed by more than 2000 Chinese students here, and warned the Danish people of the Yellow Peril (*den gule fare*) version 2.0 spreading all over Europe.

What a terrifying spy story! The article must have plenty of irrefutable evidence to support such serious espionage charge on so many people, a reader would naturally think. Let's put aside its explicit racial prejudice at the moment, and take a look at what evidence it boasts. We tried so hard to seek some concrete proof in this 6-page, some 3000-word article, and it turned out so difficult for us to finally find two cases.

Poor Evidence, Poor Logic

Firstly, two photos were sent to a big Danish company by a Cyprus detective, and somehow they found out these were taken in its factory in China. What's on these photos? Who took them and what were they used for? Do the photos contain any patented high tech? The article didn't say – but tried to indicate these were spy photos. Even if this is true, then how could this imply thousands of Chinese students/researchers here in Denmark are undercover agents?

We skip this clumsy detective plot and move on to the next, memory about an incident 20 years ago. A Chinese guest researcher wandered into another department and was fired – the company could not even explain why they fired him. It would be absurd to accuse him for espionage only because he appeared at the wrong place! Too bad the researcher didn't choose to report to the appeal board, or he would have a large chance to win the case. Again, how could this in-fact-said-nothing story suddenly become proof that Chinese researchers are spying?!

Sino-Danish Relations: the Real Picture

Let's forget about the further conjectures and exaggeration, and take a look at the real picture. Stepping into the new century, the pursuit of peace and development is the theme of the present world. The earth is becoming smaller and smaller a global village. The trend of globalization brings about many things — more convenient travels, more business potentials, enhanced exchanges in education and culture, and respect and tolerance between different peoples. Some are suspicious of the challenges of globalization but many more embrace the opportunities it brings. China plays a

special role in the world's development today, not the least due to its fastest growth rate and its opening-up policy.

The relations and cooperation between China and Denmark today is the best in history. Just to mention a few figures: bilateral trade of 25 billion Danish kroner in 2005, estimated 200,000 Chinese tourists & visitors to Denmark and 50,000 Danish to China every year, a total of 3,000 Chinese students studying in Denmark, etc. No doubt China and Denmark are both greatly benefited from the enhanced cooperation. We are also more than happy to witness the ever more friendly feeling towards China from the Danish general public in recent years, as well as the Danish government and business circle's strong will to further strengthen the political and economic ties.

China's Attitude towards Illegal Copies & Industrial Spies

As we witnessed with enthusiasm China's fast growth rate of 10% over the last two decades, we are clearly aware that many things still need to be done, and many problems need to be dealt with. For example, many Danes ask me, why the Chinese government doesn't stop the illegal copies?

The thing is – Rome is not built in one day – and just consider China's vastness! In fact, the Chinese government and local authorities are doing their utmost to hunt down the pirate copies and their producers according to China's law on Intellectual Property Rights. In 2005, China has concluded 9,380 IPR cases and detained 107,000,000 pirate copies of various types. On fighting piracy China also needs support and assistance from foreign authorities and companies – if you have a case about Chinese company/product violating IPR laws, please report to the Danish authorities, or directly to the Embassy, the Chinese Ministry of Commerce or a court of law. We'll help you hunt it down.

Speaking of industrial spies, the Chinese government opposes any conduct of illegally obtaining or sale of industrial / technological / commercial patents. Again, if you have concrete proof about someone doing this – not something like the firing-a-poor-man-because-of-nothing story – please come to the police, or directly to us. We'll assist you under the Chinese law and bring whoever involved to justice.

Racial Prejudice

What is this big story all about, I wondered aloud. To amuse readers on a Sunday morning? I wish it could be that easy – but not after I noticed with much astonishment and indignation the abuse of the Chinese national flag, and the use of this far outdated racial term *den gule fare*, the Yellow Peril. The Chinese Embassy and the Chinese communities in Denmark strongly condemn these explicit discriminative deeds towards China and the local Chinese, leading to hurt and defamation, provoking strain and hostility.

Many Danish teachers and scientists told me they like Chinese students / researchers / employees, for they are hard-working, intelligent, disciplined, and they never make trouble. Moreover, while no student has been involved in the various stories mentioned – students do not study at factories – yet

suspicion is cast on every single Chinese student abroad. Without a single shred of evidence. You may imagine how angry they are at this.

When fabricating a big story like this, when making groundless espionage accusations, when distorting the national flag of another country and using racially provocative terms, one may want to think again what he's doing. He's not only damaging his own reputation, that of the newspaper who published it, but also the image of Denmark. By making it on the cover page, he's trying consciously or unconsciously, to provoke hostility against a specific group of people and to create tension between two nations. We should never give that a chance.

A terrifying fairy tale

It is with great shock and disbelief that I read this article, as did my Chinese and Danish friends. Sensational as it may sound, the absurd espionage charge is not based on facts, but prejudice and speculations. Stuffed with outdated cold-war mentality and racist prejudice, it is so incompatible with today's world. A terrifying fairy tale. This is not the kind of article we expect from Berlingske, a newspaper generally respected for its long history and serious attitude. Unfortunately, the ethic of journalism is sometimes compromised by biased mentality of individual reporters, commercial interest of the press, or simply the desire of self-realization in making a cover story. The *Dragon's Spies (Dragens Spioner)* is yet another case on this point.
